#### INTERNATIONALISM

The International Elementary School is a state approved independently operated alternative school. It represents a fully-fledged alternative to a state-run elementary school, but features a range of additional benefits. The aim is for our students to acquire languages intensively and at an early age. This is achieved not only through actual language lessons but also by using foreign languages as the language of instruction in selected, appropriate subjects.
